

## National Coverage Determination (NCD) Update

Benefit: Screening for Lung Cancer with Low Dose Computed Tomography (LCDT)

Effective Date: February 10, 2022

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) notified its determination to expand the eligibility criteria for Medicare beneficiaries who are receiving low-dose computed tomography (LDCT), when the following criteria are met:

- 1. Being between the ages of 50 and 77
- 2. Being asymptomatic, that is, no signs or symptoms of lung cancer
- 3. Having tobacco smoking history for at least 20 pack-years
  - a. One pack year = smoke one pack a day for one year
  - b. One pack = 20 cigarettes
- 4. Be a current smoker or someone who has quit smoking in the past 15 years; AND
- 5. Receive an order for lung cancer screening with LDCT
